Day 0



DELHI / CHANDIGARH TO MANALI

- *Gather at the designated pickup spot around 9:00 PM.*
- *Meet your trip leader and fellow travelers.*
- *After a short introduction and briefing, begin your overnight drive from Delhi / Chandigarh towards Shimla.*
- *Halt for Dinner around 12 midnight near Murthal*

Day 01



MANALI SELF EXPLORE

- *Check in to the hotel, freshen up & have breakfast.*
- *A short brief for the next day to start our trip further*
- *We have kept this day for acclimatization purposes.*
- *Later head-out for self-exploration of Manali - Like Vasishta Temple, Hadimba temple, The Mall road, Jogini Waterfall.*
- *Enjoy the Dinner, Overnight stay at Manali hotel.*

Day 02



MANALI TO KAZA

- *Head early morning to Kaza via Atal tunnel. En route visit Kunzum Pass and enjoy your moment there.*
- *Drive from Batal-Chatru-Gramphu is out of the world. Enjoy the magical drive over Kunzum Pass to enter the middle land called Spiti Valley, about 9-10 hours easily if you do not get stuck in water crossings.*
- *Reach Kaza in the evening ,check in to your hotel and have your dinner.*
- *Overnight stay in Kaza.*

Day 03



ROUND KAZA

- *Drive on the twisting high roads of Spiti to reach Komic, the highest village in the world with a motorable road at 4580m.*
- *Have the most amazing experience of sending postcards to your loved ones from the World's Highest post office at Hikkim (4440m).*
- *Continue driving on these high roads above 4300m with the magnificent Himalayas jutting in front of your eyes to reach Langza - the most beautiful Himalayan Village with a 6303m Peak Mt. CCKN adorning its backdrop*
- *Overnight stay in Kaza*



KAZA TO CHANDRATAL

- *A trip to Spiti is incomplete without a visit to its iconic monastery at Kee.*
- *Built on top of a hill the main shrine is surrounded by residential quarters, and administrative buildings are built in the shape of a pyramid. This ancient marvel is a photographer's delight*
- *You'll further visit the high villages of Kibber, Chicham.*
- *heading upstream of Chandra River till you reach the Hidden Jewel of the Himalayan mountains, the blue Jewel, Chandratatal literally translated as Moon Lake.*
- *From the road head, you will have to trek for 15 min to reach the lake and if you feel energetic enough you can do the Parikrama or Circumambulation of the lake to witness its true glory*
- *Overnight stay in Chandra Tal Campsite*

Note : If due to bad weather the roads to Chandratatal stay closed, our alternate stay for the day will be arranged in Batal/Manali/Kaza

Day 05



CHANDRA TAL TO MANALI

- *This is the last day of the trip and is filled with tons of emotions.*
- *Post breakfast, we check out from Chandra Tal and start our return journey to Delhi / Chandigarh.*
- *We drive to Manali first and then an overnight journey by Volvo to Delhi / Chandigarh.*
- *Depart from Manali around 9 PM and reach Delhi / Chandigarh by 7 AM in morning.*
